Earlier in the year Selsley Community Group, organised a petition asking Kings Stanley Parish Council to address inappropriate speeds on our roads, and introduce a 20mph limit. This was overwhelmingly supported by Selsley residents. Councillors have been looking at the issue. They have sought the opinions of other parts of the parish and a survey in Kings Stanley also shows strong support for a 20 zone. Discovered that on average, every year there are two accidents within the parish that result in a minor injury, one accident that results in a serious injury and somebody dies on Kings Stanley parish roads, every five years.

KSPC have now allocated a budget to tackle the issue and are forming a committee to make changes. They will work to include the parish in Gloucestershire County Council's Community 20s and Safer Roads schemes. In other news the parish council awarded a number of grants at their November meeting, including an award of £500 to Selsley Cricket club. This will allow the club to invest in signage, improved netting, and a rubbish recycling point. There was a request from Cllr Steve Robinson (our local GCC councillor) that people keep an eye on local drain covers and if they can do so safely, keep them clear from leaves

KSPC are considering funding to repair benches near Dudbridge. This will form part of a wider initiative between SDC and the Cycle Task Force to clean up the area. Lastly, a big thank you to everybody for your cooperation on Remembrance Day when the Grove was shut for the ceremony.
